**Inspector Comments:** On this date, an investigation was conducted due to a complaint received by San Bernardino County Environmental Health Services. Upon entering facility, the person in charge was made aware of the nature of this complaint.

As per the complainant: Ate a gyro sandwich with tzaziki sauce there about 6 hours ago, just had severe vomiting

Interview:

- Person in charge was unaware of complaint.
- Person in charge stated that gyro sandwich is prepared with the following ingredients: Gyro meat, pita bread, cut tomatoes, and onions.
- According to person in charge, Tzaziki sauce is prepared at company's commissary in Vegas Ca.
- Person in charge stated that Tzaziki sauce is prepared with yogurt, cucumber, salt, and lemon.
- Spoke to owner who provided me with valid commissary health permit from Southern Nevada Health District. Commissary: Mad Food Inc Commissary.
- Owner stated that Tzaziki sauce is transported in refrigerated truck straight into facility walk in cooler.

Observation(s):

- Gyro roll being cooked with an internal temperature of 180 F
- Tzaziki sauce at 39 F inside Kenmore reach in refrigerator
- Tzaziki sauce with outer temperature of 45 F in walk in cooler ( internal temperature of 40 F)
- Cut tomatoes cooling for a few minutes at 45 F
- Pita bread manufactured by Athena Pita stored on manufacturer bag on dry storage shelf

Conclusion:

Ensure that tzaziki sauce is maintained in safe temperatures at all times.  
Complaint closed.
