**Inspector Comments:** A second re-inspection was conducted today to verify that the facility is free from vermin.

On this date, after a thorough inspection of the facility, no evidence of live or dead cockroaches was observed.

The operator stated he cleaned and sanitized the areas where vermin was observed previously during re-inspection, 6/3/19. The operator stated he used chlorine to sanitize.

The operator presented three invoices from pest control that had treated the facility. The invoices were dated for 5-31-19 and 6-3-19. Note that two visits from pest control were conducted on the same day, 6-3-19.

The health permit will now be re-instated and the facility may now open.

The closure sign has been removed and replaced with letter grade "B" card.

**Description:** Reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior inspection.
