**Inspector Comments:** A complaint was received by DEHS in regards to this facility. Complainant stated that the facility has a backed up sewage problem and it is coming up in the drain behind the counter and there is a foul odor.

Observed significant debris and mold build-up in the floor drain behind the register area. Employee stated she had not heard of any complaints regarding the floor drain odor or a sewage problem. Employee stated that when the floor drains gets covered by cigarette boxes and then the boxes are moved it does at times cause an odor to occur so she tries to leave the drain unblocked to prevent that from happening. No sewage problem has occurred at the facility recently. No odor observed at time of this inspection. Routine inspection was conducted on the same day as the complaint investigation. Corrective action in regards to this complaint is included on this report. For all other violations observed please review the routine inspection report. Complaint has been addressed.

#### 16K041 Plumbing; proper backflow devices

**Inspector Comments:** Observed significant debris and mold-like build-up in the floor drain behind the register and floor drain beneath the 3-compartment sink.

Immediately clean floor drains and maintain clean to prevent debris/mold build-up from occurring and to allow for proper drainage to occur.

**Violation Description:** The potable water supply shall be protected with a backflow or back siphonage protection device, as required by applicable plumbing codes. (114192) All plumbing and plumbing fixtures shall be installed in compliance with local plumbing ordinances, shall be maintained so as to prevent any contamination, and shall be kept clean, fully operative, and in good repair. Any hose used for conveying potable water shall be of approved materials, labeled, properly stored, and used for no other purpose.
