Inspector Comments: The purpose of this visit on 03/10/2021, was to conduct a follow up inspection on the shelf containing multiple open/damaged/taped boxes of cookies and food stored on the floor.

Observations: Upon inspection, the shelf containing multiple opened/damaged boxes of cookies were still on display for customer purchase. Numerous amounts of foods were stored directly on the floor during time of inspection .

Result: A billable follow-up inspection will be conducted to ensure damaged boxes are removed from shelves, as well as food stored at least six inches off the floor.

Description: Reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior inspection.
