Inspector Comments: This re-reinspection was requested by the person in charge of this facility. Observed closure sign remained posted on the entrance door.

The purpose of this re-reinspection was to determine compliance regarding facility closure due to evidences of active rodent infestation on 5/30/19.

OBSERVATION(S):

Observed facility was closed. Closure sign remained posted at the front entrance. No food preparation shall be allowed during closure. No evidences of recent food preparation activity was observed.

During the time of this inspection, observed evidences of active rodent activity in the dry food storage rack next to the ladder to the attic. Observed about 20 -30 rodent droppings like directly on top of unopened bag of rice, unopened bag of dry flour, an unopened box of dry seafood shell, in between approximately 25 prepackaged bags of dry wood mushroom, and at the bottom of the storage container for the dry wood mushroom. Observed wet and dry yellow rodent urine-like residue next to droppings on top of the bag of rice. Person in charged discarded food items listed above.

Person in charge was informed regarding to the billable rate of this re-reinspection of \$245.00 per hour with a minimum charge of \$122.50.

Note: during the initial reinspection on 5/31/1, inspector observed rodent dropping like at the dry storage rack in the dining area.

RESULT(S):

Facility remained closed. This facility shall not open without permission from Environmental Health Service of San Bernardino County. Closure sign remained posted. Do not deface, mar, camouflage, relocate, hide, or remove.

Failure to comply will result in billable reinspection with an hourly rate of \$245.00 per hour with a minimum charge of \$122.50.

Clean and sanitized all contaminated or suspected of contamination areas.
Discarded all contaminated food or suspected of contamination food items.
