Inspector Comments: Observed numerous employee's bottles of water on the shelf at the prep line. (b) Observed trays of employee's food on the middle shelf in the reach-in cooler. Provide cup and straw at the line and maintain employee's food on the bottom shelf at the coolers.

Violation Description: Employees shall not eat, drink, or use tobacco in non-designated areas where contamination may result. (113977) An employee shall not use a utensil to taste food more than once without being properly washed, rinsed and sanitized between uses. (113976)

Inspector Comments: Observed chili being cooled in numerous buckets of about one foot deep. Discontinue this practice and transfer PHF directly to the shallow pans after the cooking process.

Violation Description: All potentially hazardous food shall be RAPIDLY cooled from 135F to 70F, within 2 hours, and then from 70F to 41 F, within 4 hours. Cooling shall be by one or more of the following methods: in shallow containers; separating food into smaller portions; adding ice as an ingredient; using an ice bath; stirring frequently; using rapid cooling equipment; or, using containers that facilitate heat transfer. PHF is to be cooled within 4 hours to 41F if prepared from ingredients at ambient temperature. Deliveries of PHF is to be cooled to below 41F within 4 hours if received between 41F to 45F.

Inspector Comments: Observed numerous dead new cockroaches on 2 glue traps against the wall at the cooking pots. Continue to work on eliminating all signs of vermin from the facility.

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. (114259.4, 114259.5)
