<b>POINTS</b> <b>4</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 113967, 113976,	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed ten (10) severely seam dented cans of food on the display shelving. These cans were voluntarily withdrawn for sale pending destruction or return to vendor.  Do not sell any caned goods that are severely dented on the seams or rim, or cans that are swollen or leaking.  Violation corrected on site.
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**Violation Description:** All food shall be manufactured, produces, prepared, compounded, packed, transported, kept for sale, and served so as to be pure and free from adulteration and spoilage. Any food is adulterated if it bears or contains any poisonous or deleterious substance that may render it impure or injurious to health. (113967, 113976, 113980, 113988, 113990, 114035, 114254(c), 114254.3)

**23. NO RODENTS, INSECTS, BIRDS, OR ANIMALS** **MAJOR**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>4</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114259.1, 114259.4, 11425	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed a dozen or more live German cockroaches (adults and nymphs) in the back storage area at the mop sink.  Immediately eliminate the cockroach infestation. A reinspection will be conducted on or around October 29, 2019 to ensure compliance.
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**Violation Description:** Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. (114259.4, 114259.5)

**6. ADEQUATE HANDWASHING FACILITIES SUPPLIED & ACCESSIBLE**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>2</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference -	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed the soap dispenser in the employee restroom to be broken. Also, a bar of soap was observed on the rim of the sink.  Discontinue the use of bar soap. Repair or replace the soap dispenser and keep it stocked at all times.
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**Violation Description:** Handwashing soap and towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. (113953.2) Adequate facilities shall be provided for hand washing. (113953, 113953.1, 114067(f)). Handwashing sink is not separated from a warewashing sink by a 6 inch high metal splashguard or 24 inch separation. (113953) Handwashing sinks shall not be obstructed, inaccessible, used improperly or kept unclean. (113953.1)

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114047, 114049, 114051	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed a container of milk being stored directly on the floor of the walk-in refrigerator.  Store all foods at least six (6) inches off the ground on approved racks.
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**Violation Description:** Food shall be stored in approved containers and labeled as to contents. Food shall be stored at least 6" above the floor on approved shelving in an approved location to prevent possible contamination. (114047, 114049, 114051, 114053, 114055, 114067(h), 14069 (b))

**33. NONFOOD-CONTACT SURFACES CLEAN**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114115 (c)	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> 1) Observed old food debris on the floor of the walk-in refrigerator and freezer.  Clean the floors and maintain them in clean condition.  2) Observed accumulations of dust on the fan guards and neoprene pipe wrapping in the walk-in refrigerator.  Clean these areas and maintain them in clean condition.
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**Violation Description:** All nonfood contact surfaces of utensils and equipment shall be clean. (114115 (c))

(114130, 114130.1, 114130.2, 114130.3, 114130.4, 114130.5, 114132, 114133, 114137, 114139, 114153, 114155, 114163, 114165, 114167, 114169, 114177, 114180, 114182)

Violation Description: The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143 (d), 114257, 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272) Cleaning must be an approved dustless method. (114268.1) Mats and duckboards, if used, must be removable and easily cleanable. (114272) Open-air barbecues or wood-burning ovens floor surfaces must extend a minimum of five feet and be impervious or easily cleanable. (114143(d))

IMPORTANT: Risk Based Inspection Frequency

Food facilities that pose a higher risk level for causing foodborne illness will be subject to an additional inspection, to be billed at the hourly rate as provided in the San Bernardino County Code Schedule of Fees. Facilities that received one or more of the following will be elevated to a high risk tier:

- A score letter of "C" or lower on one of the last two graded inspections,
- A score letter of "B" on two of the last three graded inspections,
- Repeated "four (4) point violation Risk Factor" (critical violation codes 1-23) on the last two inspections, or
- Four (4) or more critical violations (codes 1-23) noted during an inspection, or
- A permit suspension (closure) on your last graded inspection.
