**Inspector Comments:** On this date a follow up investigation was conducted by the San Bernardino County Division of Environmental Health Services.

The following was observed:

- In the second story closet, faux bathroom, and entertainment room no rodent droppings.
- Kitchen below all equipment types; mop sink, cold holding unit, grill unit / all cooking equipment no rodent droppings.
- Back storage area, cold holding area, ice machine, metal storage racks, all food cans free of rodent droppings.
- Back trash area, no rodent droppings.
- All holes were covered and stuffed with cocking to remove entrance of vermin.
- No flies were observed in the facility.
- A pest control paper was provided which stated rodent droppings were removed and contaminated areas were sanitized. And all structural damages were repaired.

No Further action is Required. Facility may open to the public.
