A compliant inspection was conducted on this date in response to complaint number CO0077704.

NATURE OF COMPLAINT:

The complainant alleged that they observed a live cockroach on the food counter at the facility.

OBSERVATION(S):

The following observations were conducted at this time:

-On 3/27/2021, the owner received temporary permission by San Bernardino County Environmental Health Services (EHS) to reopen and remove the "Notice of Closure" sign at the facility's window. The owner was informed that a billable reinspection will be conducted at a later date, to verify the removal and sanitation of cockroaches within the facility.

-On 3/29/2021, the owner notified San Bernardino County EHS regarding self-closure of the facility due to sightings of live cockroaches within the facility.

-On this date (3/31/2021), observed facility to be locked and closed at this time. Observed sign posted stating the facility will remain closed until Friday, 4/2/2021. Observed "Notice of Closure" sign to be removed. Observed facility closed to the public.

OUTCOME:
