Inspector Comments: A complaint investigation was conducted on this date in response to a complaint received by Environmental Health Services regarding a sewage backup.

Observed the facility open upon arrival for complaint investigation. According to the person in charge, they were not aware that they should self-close in the event of a sewage backup. Observed hot and cold water available at the 3-compartment sink, however the waste water was unable to drain properly. Observed standing water in the floor drain underneath the 3-compartment sink. Observed the hot and cold water valves at the handwashing sink and mop sink to be shut off at time of investigation. Observed hot and cold water available at the handwash sink inside the restroom, however the toilet facilities were nonoperational.

At this time, the health permit of the facility is hereby suspended due to the nonoperational sewage/wastewater disposal system and inoperable toilet facilities. A Notice of Closure was posted on this date. Do not remove, relocate, or alter the Notice of Closure. A reinspection is required to reinstate the health permit and verify proper disposal of sewage and wastewater.

Violation Description: All liquid waste must drain to an approved fully functioning sewage disposal system. (114197) Toilet facilities must be operable.
