Inspector Comments: The health permit for this facility was suspended on 12/26/2018 due to an imminent health hazard of cockroach infestation.

The facility owner attended a Supervisory review on 12/27/2018 at the department offices located in San Bernardino. Per the Supervisory review agreement the owner agreed to ensure that the facility is maintained in a clean and sanitary manner. The facility owner agreed to complete all recommended measures to prevent vermin entry and stated that all gaps in the bar area and below the bar counter had been sealed to prevent further vermin entrance and harborage in the facility. The owner shall take measures to prevent accumulation of food debris and unused equipment which can lead to vermin harborage. The billable re-inspection is being done at this time at the owners request. The facility was observed to have operable flashlights to assist in monitoring, cleaning and treating of areas where vermin have been found.

At the time of this reopening inspection the facility was observed to have all gaps below and behind the bar sealed with spray foam insulation and caulking. No live or dead cockroaches were visible at the time of this inspection. A follow-up has been scheduled with Dewey pest control for 12/28/2018 at 7:30AM to conduct follow up treatment.

A billable follow up will be conducted on 1-2-2018 to verify continued compliance with elimination of the infestation. All pest control record shall be made available to the health inspector at the time of the inspection to verify compliance with treatment and preventive measures. It is highly recommended, as indicated in the supervisory review agreement, that the owner maintain pest control services at a higher frequency than once per month initially until the infestation has been completely abated, and then increased to monthly services and as needed.

The notice of closure sign will be taken down and the earned letter grade "C" will be placed. Any indication of live cockroach activity or evidence of live cockroach activity and continued infestation observed during the follow up inspection will result in re-closure of the facility. Due to the "C" grade the facility shall submit a request for rescore to DEHS prior to January 18th to avoid reclosure.

Description: The health permit to operate is hereby reinstated and facility may open.

16K993 Re-Reinspection

Inspector Comments: A billable re-opening inspection of the facility was requested by the owner on this date. The re-opening inspection is the result of a closure of the facility on 12/26/2018 due to active and heavy cockroach infestation in critical areas of the facility.

At the time of this reopening inspection no signs of live cockroaches were observed in the facility.

The health permit to operate this facility is hereby reinstated this date and the facility is reopened. Continue to operate this kitchen facility free from vermin- including but not limited to cockroaches.

Inspector Comments: A follow up was conducted to verify elimination of cockroaches from the facility.

The facility was closed on 12/26/2018 during a re-inspection for a closure for cockroach infestation observed on 12/20/2018.

The following was observed during the previous inspection that resulted in closure of the facility on 12/26/2018:

- Live cockroaches
- 1) Evidence of heavy active cockroach infestation observed:
 - a) Live cockroaches observed throughout the bar area including:
 - between the bottom portion of the wood counter tops and the metal brackets below the counter top
 - In the crevices between pieces of wood below the counter tops
 - In the walls and gaps in the walls directly below and behind the 3-compartment sink.
 - Pest control services are scheduled for 1/2/2019

On this date the following was observed:

At the time of this reopening inspection the facility was observed to have all gaps below and behind the bar sealed with spray foam insulation and caulking. No live or dead cockroaches were visible at the time of this inspection. A follow-up has been scheduled with Dewey pest control for 12/28/2018 at 7:30AM to conduct follow up treatment.

The facility shall continue to clean, sanitize, monitor, and treat the facility to completely eliminate the cockroach infestation and evidence of the infestation. All food contact surfaces in the facility shall be cleaned and sanitized using appropriate methods. All vermin harborage areas shall be cleaned, sanitized, sealed, monitored, and treated using approved pest control methods.

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. (114259.4, 114259.5)

Overall Inspection Comments

For a C grade (score of 70 to 79)

The food facility must correct the deficiencies listed in the Official Inspection Report (OIR) and must submit to our Division a written request for a re-score inspection within 30 days of the OIR. The Health Official will complete the re-score inspection within ten (10) County business days of the food facility submitting a request for a re-score inspection. A food facility failing to comply with the OIR, failing to attain at least a "B" grade on the re-score inspection, or failing to request a re-score inspection may be immediately closed by the Health Official and remain closed until at least a "B" grade is achieved on a re-score inspection. The inspection rate is \$245.00 per hour. A minimum of \$122.50 will be charged for the first 30 minutes of inspection time. A Letter Grade Card shall remain valid until the Health Official completes the next routine inspection or re-score inspection of the food facility. A re-score inspection is a new, unscheduled, complete routine inspection that a) may be required by County Ordinance #33.1403; or b) may be requested by the food facility.
