Inspector Comments: Reinspection conducted on this day as a follow-up to permit being suspend due to one (1) live adult german cockroach and one (1) live nymph german cockroach on floor beneath stand-up reach-in-coolers, along with dead cockroaches on floor beneath stand-up reach-in-coolers.

Owner was advised to obtain an approved form of pest control or take other approved measures to eliminate cockroaches from facility. Owner was also advised to clean and sanitize all affected and contaminated areas, as well as all areas containing food residue and food debris.

Food debris and residue was observed cleaned from floors beneath all equipment in kitchen area and from walls where stand-up coolers are located. Food residue and debris also observed removed from wire shelving and table-top equipment in facility.

During reinspection, two (2) live nymph, german cockroaches were observed on floor beneath stand up reach-in coolers (see no rodent, insects violation).

Permit remains suspended and facility closed due to evidence of active cockroach infestation.

Contact EHS for charged re-reinspection once vermin is eliminated from facility.

Description: Reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior inspection.

Inspector Comments: Two (2) live nymph, german cockroaches were observed on floor beneath stand up reach-in coolers.

Eliminate cockroaches and maintain facility free from all vermin.

Owner stated pest control was contacted to service facility 3/5/22. Contact EHS for charged re-reinspection to ensure elimination of cockroaches from facility prior to opening and operating.

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. (114259.4, 114259.5)
