16K999 Complaint Inspection Compliance Date: Not Specified Inspector Comments: The purpose of this visit was to conduct a complaint investigation. Nature of Complaint: The complainant stated the cafe at this Barnes & Noble location is full of roaches. The Reference - HSC complainant stated the complainant saw them on the floors and counters behind the register while ordering from there recently. The management did not hear about this complaint. On this date, the manager stated the pest control service was performed on Wednesday, 09/30/2020. The manager provided the log from the computer. Observed no pest control service report at the time of this investigation. The manager stated when this facility reopened, two (2) to three (3) month ago, there were the activities of cockroaches due to construction of next building, so the manager contacted the professional pest control service at that time. The manager stated he did not observe any activities recently. On this date, Observed four (4) live german nymph and adult cockroaches in the cabinet under the table across the cash register and under the small double door reach-in refrigeration unit under the espresso machine and several dead cockroaches on the coffee preparation area. Observed openings in the ceiling above the walk-in refrigerator and freezer and gaps between the walls and cove base at the 3-compartment sink and the mop sink. This food facility was closed, and the health permit was suspended on this date. A reinspecton is required prior to reopen this food facility. Ensure to take appropriate pest control measures to eliminate all evidence of past or current vermin from this facility including but not limited to rodents. Clean and sanitize affected area in an approved manner. The graded inspection was conducted at the same time of this complaint investigation. Refer the graded inspection report for additional information.
