POINTS 4	Compliance date not specified Complied on 4/30/2015 Violation Reference - HSC - 113984(e), 114097, 114099	Inspector Comments: Observed the water temperature in the "washing" sink compartment during active ware washing to be 82 degrees F. Ensure that the temperature of the water in this compartment is at or above 100 degrees F during active warewashing. Corrective action at time of inspection: Employee drained the first compartment and re-filled with water of appropriate temperature for ware washing.
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Violation Description: All food contact surfaces of utensils and equipment shall be clean and sanitized. (113984(e), 114097, 114099.1, 114099.4, 114099.6, 114101 (b-d), 114105, 114109, 114111, 114113, 114115 (a, b, d), 114117, 114125(b), 114135, 114141)

38. ADEQUATE VENTILATION AND LIGHTING; DESIGNATED AREA

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114149, 114149.1	Inspector Comments: Observed gaps between the filters underneath the exhaust hood filter system at cooks line. Eliminate all gaps between filters and ensure ventilation frames are fitted properly to allow proper air flow and prevent grease leak.
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Violation Description: Exhaust hoods shall be provided to remove toxic gases, heat, grease, vapors and smoke and be approved by the local building department. Canopy-type hoods shall extend 6" beyond all cooking equipment. All areas shall have sufficient ventilation to facilitate proper food storage. Toilet rooms shall be vented to the outside air by a screened openable window, an air shaft, or a light-switch activated exhaust fan, consistent with local building codes. (114149, 114149.1) Adequate lighting shall be provided in all areas to facilitate cleaning and inspection. Light fixtures in areas where open food is stored, served, prepared, and where utensils are washed shall be of shatterproof construction or protected with light shields. (114149.2, 114149.3, 114252, 114252.1)

43. TOILET FACILITIES: PROPERLY CONSTRUCTED, SUPPLIED, CLEANED

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114250, 114276	Inspector Comments: Observed half-used rolls of toilet paper stored directly on top of toilet tank and on top of cabinet within the women's restroom. Also observed paper towels stored on top of paper towel dispenser within women's restroom (paper towels were also observed within the dispenser). Ensure that toilet facilities are maintained clean and fully stocked (but not overstocked) with supplies in their appropriate dispensers at all times.
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Violation Description: Toilet facilities shall be maintained clean, sanitary and in good repair for use by employees and patrons. Toilet rooms shall be separated by a well-fitting, self-closing door. Toilet tissue shall be provided in a permanently installed dispenser at each toilet. Location of toilet facilities used by patrons shall not be located to pass through food preparation, food storage, or utensil washing areas. (114250, 114250.1, 114276)

47. SIGNS POSTED; LAST INSPECTION REPORT AVAILABLE

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 113725.1, 113953.5	Inspector Comments: A copy of the most recent routine inspection report was not available upon request at the facility. Ensure that a copy of the most recent inspection report is printed and maintained onsite at the facility at all times.
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Violation Description: Handwashing signs shall be posted in each toilet room, directing attention to the need to thoroughly wash hands after using the restroom (113953.5) (b) No smoking signs shall be posted in food preparation, food storage, warewashing, and utensil storage areas (113978). (c) Consumers shall be notified that clean tableware is to be used when they return to self-service areas such as salad bars and buffets. (d) Any food facility constructed before January 1, 2004 without public toilet facilities, shall prominently post a sign within the food facility in a public area stating that toilet facilities are not provided (113725.1, 114381 (e)). A sign shall be posted stating that a copy of the most recent routine inspection report is available upon request. (113725.1) Permit shall be posted in conspicuous location. (114381(e)) Letter Grade Placecard shall be properly posted. SBCC 33.1406

Ensure that all employees obtain a valid San Bernardino County Food Worker Card within 14 days of this inspection. Failure to provide our office with proof of compliance within 14 business days will result in a charged inspection billed at a rate of \$245 per hour with a 30-minute minimum or other further action. Fax provided Missing Food Worker Card form to DEHS office at (909) 387-4272.
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Violation Description: This facility is currently in violation with the food worker certification requirement for San Bernardino County, which states all food workers must obtain a valid food worker certificate within fourteen (14) days of employment (33.0410, 33.044). Failure to provide proof of food worker certification within fourteen (14) days will result in unannounced billable (at our current hourly rate) re-inspections to verify compliance.
