Inspector Comments: Reinspection conducted on this day as a follow-up to complaint and routine inspections conducted on 6/8/22. On that day the food and beverage portion of facility was closed due to lack of potable water in facility.

During reinspection water was observed functional at all faucets throughout facility, including drinking fountains.

The following temperatures were observed at the respective sinks:

- 100.4F at nonadjustable handwashing sink located in customer toilet facility
- 107.9F at nonadjustable handwashing sink located in customer toilet facility
- Above 145F at janitorial sink

The following actions are required to be completed no later than 11/13/22 to avoid closure and/or charged follow-up inspections:

- 1) Backflow prevention device shall be installed between fire suppression water tank and potable water supply tank.
- 2) Barrier must be provided to prevent public access to potable water supply system.
- 3) Quarterly E. coli samples must be taken and submitted with negative results.

Provide EHS with above required information to confirm compliance.

Description: Reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior inspection.

Overall Inspection Comments

Permit reinstated; Facility may resume sales of food and beverages due to correction of critical violation.
