Inspector Comments: On this date a follow-up inspection was conducted to verify facility is free of vermin evidence.

During a complaint inspection on 6/3/22 the inspector found the following:

- 1 dead juvenile cockroach on floor of dining room near front door
- 1 dead adult cockroach on floor under the hand wash sink
- 1 dead adult cockroach on floor in cabinet below the soda machine
- floors throughout the facility under equipment to have a heavy accumulation of old foods and trash

On this date no evidence of live or dead roaches were observed.

Person in charge stated the pest control company had visited the facility on this date but is still in the process of scheduling a date to treat facility.

Along with the follow-up inspection a routine inspection was conducted that resulted in a letter a grade "A" to be posted.

Description: Reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior inspection.

Inspector Comments: Observed all floor sinks in facility to not properly drain. Person in charge avoided turning on the water so the drains would not overflow.

All floor sinks must properly drain into a sewage system.

Note: Person in charge called plumber onsite. Plumber cleared pipes and floor drains were operable.

Violation Description: All liquid waste must drain to an approved fully functioning sewage disposal system. (114197) Toilet facilities must be operable.

Overall Inspection Comments

A follow-up inspection was conducted on this date.

No vermin evidence or activity observed on this date.
