Inspector Comments: The purpose of this visit is to conduct a complaint investigation.

Reference - HSC

A complaint was received by San Bernardino County Environmental Health Services on May, 10, 2021.

The complainant stated the following:

- -they were eating in the dinning room area when they saw a mouse by the trash can.
- -an employee was made aware who also saw the mouse and took a picture of it.

On this date the following information was provided/observed:

- -operator was unaware of this complaint.
- -per operator pest control has been treating the facility every day since the last complaint inspection which was on April 21, 2021, some receipts were provided.
- -various rat traps were observed on the floor throughout and outside the facility.
- -pest control receipt for May 11, 2021 stated that one adult rodent died inside one of the exterior rodent stations and a juvenile rodent was disposed which was caught on a trap.
- -pest control receipt for May 06, 2021 stated that they responded to a call back in regards to the customer who saw a rodent in the dinning room area and ran out of an open door.
- -operator also stated that the every night the facility is cleaned and sanitized especially where rodent droppings are found and that every morning new droppings are found in the facility.
- -several fresh rodent droppings were observed on the floor underneath the manual dishwashing machine, on the dishwashing machine adjacent to clean dish storage rack, behind the M3 Turbo Air Freezer located in the kitchen, underneath the fryers in the kitchen, underneath the cold holding table adjacent to air freezer in the kitchen, and on the floor adjacent to the heater.
- -heavy food debris build up was observed on the floor underneath the cold hold table in the kitchen, on the floor underneath the M3 Turbo air freezer, and underneath the fryers.

Inspector Comments: Eliminate vermin from facility.

- 1. Put away food and utensils, clean and sanitize all affected areas throughout the facility in an approved manner. Eliminate all vermin/evidence of vermin throughout the facility.
- 2. Clean and sanitize all areas listed (in this report) with heavy grease buildups and old food debris throughout the facility.
- 3. Take appropriate pest control measures. Obtain pest control record detailing all areas serviced and types of services. Demonstrate all actions taken to eliminate vermin infestation.
- 4. Properly clean and sanitize all food contact surfaces, cooking equipment at the cook's line so as to be in a clean and sanitary condition and will avoid contamination.
- 5. Clean up all clusters from the dry storage room, eliminate all unused equipment, personal items from the dry storage room.

Contact San Bernardino County Environmental Health Services to schedule a re-inspection.

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. (114259.4, 114259.5)
