Inspector Comments: You are hereby notified that your open food Health Permit is temporarily suspended due to an active German cockroach infestation.

- Remove/eliminate all evidence of the cockroaches using an approved method of pest control as soon as possible.
- Seal all gaps/crevices in the facility.
- Clean and sanitize the affected areas.

All evidence of cockroach activity must be eliminated from the facility prior to reopening.

*****THE FACILITY MUST REMAIN CLOSED FOR AT LEAST 24 HOURS AND MUST HAVE A REINSPECTION BY ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH SERVICE BEFORE FACILITY MAY OPEN*****

Inspector Comments: Purpose: The purpose of this visit is to investigate a complaint received about this facility.

Nature of complaint: Complainant stated that they saw a cockroach on the hot food counter.

Observations: Operator stated that they were unaware of this complaint. Operator stated that that the facility was treated by a professional pest control company "etech pest solutions". Observed receipt from "etech pest solutions" dated 11/17/21 that stated "cockroach activity found". Observed more than ten (10) live nymph German cockroaches on wall and floor behind/under soda syrup box rack located in rear storage room behind hot-holding food unit, see violation 16C023.

Outcome: Based on the information obtained during complaint investigation, this complaint is plausible. The open food health permit is temporarily suspended, see violation 16K995. A follow-up inspection will be conducted.

Description: A complaint report has been received by Environmental Health.

16C023 No rodents, insects, birds, or animals

Inspector Comments: Observed more than ten (10) live nymph German cockroaches on wall and floor behind/under soda syrup box rack located in rear storage room behind hot-holding food unit.

Ensure facility is maintained free of vermin and evidence of vermin.

Eliminate all evidence of vermin from this facility. Clean and sanitize affected area and maintain clean and sanitary.

NOTE: Due to active German cockroach infestation, the open food Health Permit has been temporarily suspended, see violation 16K995.

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. (114259.4, 114259.5)



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16C041 Plumbing; proper backflow devices

Inspector Comments: Observed missing air gap between the bottom of the drainage pipe and the top of the floor sink near soda syrup box rack located in rear storage room.

Ensure an air gap between the bottom of the drainage pipe and top of the floor sink of at least one (1) inch or twice the diameter of the drainage pipe.

Provide the proper air gap at floor sink(s) mentioned above and maintain in good repair.

Violation Description: The potable water supply shall be protected with a backflow or back siphonage protection device, as required by applicable plumbing codes. (114192) All plumbing and plumbing fixtures shall be installed in compliance with local plumbing ordinances, shall be maintained so as to prevent any contamination, and shall be kept clean, fully operative, and in good repair. Any hose used for conveying potable water shall be of approved materials, labeled, properly stored, and used for no other purpose. (114171, 114189.1, 114190, 114193, 114193.1, 114199, 114201, 114269)

16C045 Floors, walls and ceilings: built, maintained, and clean

Inspector Comments: Observed multiple gaps in walls around piping and conduit near soda syrup box rack located in rear storage room near/behind hot-holding food unit.

Ensure all walls are maintained in good repair.

Enclose/ seal all gaps in walls and maintain in good repair.

Violation Description: The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143 (d), 114257, 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272) Cleaning must be an approved dustless method. (114268.1) Mats and duckboards, if used, must be removable and easily cleanable. (114272) Open-air barbecues or wood-burning ovens floor surfaces must extend a minimum of five feet and be impervious or easily cleanable. (114143(d))
