Inspector Comments: Complainant stated that there was a dog in the kitchen at this facility, and that there were customers cooking in the kitchen, and that the kitchen was filthy.

Reference - HSC

Observed the following:

1. There were no animals in the facility during this inspection.
2. There were no customers in the kitchen.
3. rodent droppings in several locations in kitchen. Rodent droppings did not appear fresh.

Instructed owner to use a bleach/water mixture to wet droppings, clean up droppings, and sanitize areas cleaned up with bleach after droppings are removed. Instructed owner to fill or cover all holes and routes of entry for vermin. Instructed owner to remove clutter so that a clean facility may be maintained and because rodents like to reside in the clutter.

A routine inspection was conducted at this time and may be consulted for further information.

A reinspection will occur within three weeks.
