Inspector Comments: Observed that facility did not have water at any sink because water had been turned off to facility due to a water leak at the water filtration system.

Permit suspended due to lack of hot water. Permit suspension sign posted at front of facility and food area was taped off with yellow tape that just allowed customers to approach point of sale to purchase fuel. Once water filtration system has been repaired and facility has hot water, contact San Bernardino County Environmental Health Services at (800)442-2283 for a reinspection prior to operating food facility.

Violation Description: Violation(s) observed pose an immediate threat to public health and safety and the health permit to operate is hereby suspended and ordered closed until the listed violation(s) have been corrected and verified by DEHS. Facility is to remain closed until permission from DEHS is given. Contact your inspector at your local office to schedule a reinspection to reinstate the health permit. Posted closed, do not move, hide, or remove sign.
