Ensure that sanitizing solutions are available in buckets for wiping food contact surfaces. Maintain sanitizing solutions at 100ppm for chlorine and 200ppm for quaternary ammonia. Store wiping cloths in sanitizing solution in buckets prior to and after each use. Corrected during inspection.
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Violation Description: All food contact surfaces of utensils and equipment shall be clean and sanitized. (113984(e), 114097, 114099.1, 114099.4, 114099.6, 114101 (b-d), 114105, 114109, 114111, 114113, 114115 (a, b, d), 114117, 114125(b), 114135, 114141)

(113947) Food facilities that prepare, handle or serve non-prepackaged potentially hazardous food, shall have an employee who has passed an approved food safety certification examination. POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference -	Inspector Comments: Observed employees' foods/drinks on various surfaces in food preparation area/kitchen. Provide designated space(s) for employee items. Ensure that employees do not eat or drink in food preparation areas/kitchen.
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Violation Description: Employees shall not eat, drink, or use tobacco in non-designated areas where contamination may result. (113977) An employee shall not use a utensil to taste food more than once without being properly washed, rinsed and sanitized between uses. (113976)

7. PROPER HOT AND COLD HOLDING TEMPERATURES

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 113996, 113998, 114037	Inspector Comments: Observed the temperature of food items in the walk-in refrigerator at 50°F for cooked pork and 47°F for cooked beans. Maintain cold food temperatures at 41°F or below.
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Violation Description: Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41F or at or above 135F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a))

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Violation Description: All food shall be separated and protected from contamination. (113984 (a, b, c, d, f), 113986, 114060, 114067(a, d, e, j), 114069(a, b), 114077, 114089.1 (c), 114143 (c)) All food shall be stored, prepared, displayed or held so that it is protected from contamination.



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29. TOXIC SUBSTANCES PROPERLY IDENTIFIED, STORED, USED

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114254, 114254.1	Inspector Comments: Observed spray bottles of cleaning chemicals on shelves with retail foods. Provide a designated place for the storage of chemicals. Corrected during inspection.
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Violation Description: All poisonous substances, detergents, bleaches, and cleaning compounds shall be stored separate from food, utensils, packing material and food-contact surfaces. (114254, 114254.1, 114254.2) An insecticide, rodenticide, or other pesticide must be used in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.

33. NONFOOD-CONTACT SURFACES CLEAN

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114115 (c)	Inspector Comments: Observed dirt buildup inside and outside the ice machine. Provide thorough and regular cleaning.
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Violation Description: All nonfood contact surfaces of utensils and equipment shall be clean. (114115 (c))

40. WIPING CLOTHS: PROPERLY USED AND STORED

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114135, 114185.1	Inspector Comments: Observed wet wiping cloths on counter tops. Place wiping cloths in sanitizing buckets prior to and after each use, or store in other approved storage immediately after each use. Corrected during inspection.
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Violation Description: Wiping cloths used to wipe service counters, scales or other surfaces that may come into contact with food shall be used only once unless kept in clean water with sanitizer. (114135, 114185.1, 114185.3 (d-e)) Sponges shall not be used in contact with cleaned and sanitized or in-use food contact surfaces. (114135)

47. SIGNS POSTED; LAST INSPECTION REPORT AVAILABLE

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 113725.1, 113953.5	Inspector Comments: The last inspection report was not observed on site at time of inspection. Maintain a copy of the current inspection report on site at all times.
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Violation Description: Handwashing signs shall be posted in each toilet room, directing attention to the need to thoroughly wash hands after using the restroom (113953.5) (b) No smoking signs shall be posted in food preparation, food storage, warewashing, and utensil storage areas (113978). (c) Consumers shall be notified that clean tableware is to be used when they return to self-service areas such as salad bars and buffets. (d) Any food facility constructed before January 1, 2004 without public toilet facilities, shall prominently post a sign within the food facility in a public area stating that toilet facilities are not provided (113725.1, 114381 (e)). A sign shall be posted stating that a copy of the most recent routine inspection report is available upon request. (113725.1) Permit shall be posted in conspicuous location. (114381(e)) Letter Grade Placecard shall be properly posted. SBCC 33.1406
