Inspector Comments: A reinspection is being conducted this date to observe if roaches have been eliminated from facility. Upon the routine inspection conducted on 5/3/18, live roaches and dead roaches were observed on the floors, walls, and ceilings, and in the bus bins in the dry storage areas and in the kitchens. Facility was closed due to the roach infestation and due to a score below a "70". Facility was advised that facility would not be reopened until all evidence of cockroach infestation from the affected areas, and all affected areas and utensils and surfaces have been cleaned and sanitized, an approved method of pest control has been provided, all gaps in the floors, walls, and ceilings have been sealed, and a mandatory supervisory consultation meeting has been attended.

Not In Compliance

Owner of facility attended the mandatory supervisory consultation on 5/3/18.
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No evidence of roaches observed. All surfaces have been cleaned and sanitized. Professional pest control has been provided and a monthly pest control service has been obtained. All gaps in floors, walls, and ceilings has been sealed.

Description: Reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior inspection.
