Manager stated as soon as they were made aware of the complaint they had their pest control service Dewey Pest Control come out to provide service, receipt indicate service done on 9-22-2020

Pest control receipt note the following:" Inspected building for signs of rodent activity. Activity found, possible mice evidence placed 12- glue traps in register and back prep area. Also placed 4 T-rex traps in lower register area and will follow up by 9-24-2020 to monitor any activity if any"

Inspector Comments: Observed the following evidence of vermin infestation on this day:

Not In Compliance

- Approximately 7-15 dark brown fresh droppings underneath cabinet area behind front register where there are boxes of condiments and paper goods.

Violation Reference - HSC - 114259.1, 114259.4, 11425

- Approximately 5-6 dark brown fresh droppings inside an open box of individually packages mayonnaise and also about three of these packages were gnawed and busted open.

- Approximately 5 droppings behind Pepsi refrigeration unit where cold drinks are stored.

- Approximately 7-10 dark brown fresh droppings underneath cabinet to self serve soda station.

Ensure to clean and sanitize ALL affected areas prior to re-opening.

No exposed areas of possible entry observed on this day.

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. IMMEDIATE HEALTH PERMIT SUSPENSION AND CLOSURE The permit to operate the above named food facility is hereby temporarily suspended, and the facility is ordered to immediately closed under the authority of Sections 114405 and 114409 of Division 104, Part 7, Chapter 13 Article 3 of the California Health and Safety Code. The attached inspection report specifies the conditions that warrant this closure and the sections of the law that have are being violated. Any food facility for which the permit has been temporarily suspended shall cease all food handling, close and remain closed until all conditions warranting the closure are corrected and your permit has been reinstated by a representative of Environmental Health. You are hereby notified that you have the right to request a hearing, within 15 calendar days after service of this notice to show cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Your failure to request a hearing within 15 days shall be deemed a waiver of your right to a hearing. An owner, manager, or operator who fails to comply with this Closure Notice may be found guilty of a misdemeanor, with a possible fine of \$1000.00 and/or imprisonment for not more than six months for each offense. This Health Permit Suspension and Closure Notice is issued to you under the authority of the California Health and Safety Code, Division 104, Part 7, Chapter 13, Article 3. Copies of the Code Sections referred to herein may be reviewed at most public libraries, the internet, or Environmental Health.
