**Inspector Comments:** A complaint investigation was conducted on this date in response to complaint CO0070813 received by Environmental Health Services on 06/24/2020.

Reference - HSC

According to record details, the complainant visited the facility at approximately 3:15 AM on 06/23/2020 and saw 3 small roaches in the fountain soda beverage area.

On this date, the owner was present for the complaint investigation. The owner said he was aware about this complaint and had received notice of cockroach activity from his employees. The owner stated the facility is treated by Kaizen Pest Control Services on a monthly basis and confirmed by phone call that the representative treated the facility this past Monday, on 06/29/2020. On this date, 1 dead adult cockroach and 3 live nymphs were observed next to the floor drain underneath the 3-compartment sink. A thorough investigation was conducted throughout the front customer service area, front cashier area, back dry storage area, and inside the walk in cooler. Signs of additional cockroach activity were not observed in any other areas.

In the dry storage area, fresh rodent droppings were observed along the shelves and floor. The owner was aware about this issue and stated the facility was also being treated for rodents at this time. Observed rodent droppings on shelves containing prepackaged boxes of disposable cups and miscellaneous items. Observed rodent droppings underneath the fountain soda beverage area and rodent traps throughout the rear dry storage area.

On this date, the health permit has been hereby suspended due to active vermin activity. The facility will be closed at this time. A Notice of Closure was posted at the front entrance to the facility. Do NOT reopen the facility or remove the Notice of Closure sign without the approval of San Bernardino County Environmental Health Services. A reinspection is required to verify the elimination of all rodent and cockroach activity. To schedule a reinspection, call 1-800-442-2283.

**Inspector Comments:** 1) On this date, 1 dead adult cockroach and 3 live nymph cockroaches were observed by the floor drain underneath the 3-compartment sink in the rear dry storage area.

2) Rodent droppings were observed throughout the rear dry storage area. Observed heavy accumulation of rodent droppings on the shelves and floor in the back of the dry storage area and underneath the fountain soda syrup dispensing area.

Ensure to eliminate all evidence of current and/or past vermin activity. Ensure to clean and sanitize all areas where rodent droppings and cockroach activities were observed.

**Violation Description:** Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code.
