POINTS 4	Compliance date not specified Complied on 4/27/2016 Violation Reference - HSC - 113996, 113998, 114037	Inspector Comments: Observed numerous potential hazardous foods (PHF) in cooks line reach-in at temperature ranging from 43F to 56F. Discontinue use of this refrigeration unit until food temperatures can be maintained below 41F. See VC & D.
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Violation Description: Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41F or at or above 135F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a))

9. PROPER COOLING METHODS **⚠ CRITICAL ⚠**

POINTS 4	Compliance date not specified Complied on 4/27/2016 Violation Reference - HSC - 114000	Inspector Comments: Observed large container of cooked gravy at 70 F cooked the previous day; two (2) large soup containers at 44 F- 56 F cooling in the walk-in. All PHF items to be rapidly cooled from 135 F to 70 F in two (2) hours and 70 F 41 F in four (4) hours. Use shallow stainless steel pans to facilitate cooling. One soup container made in the morning was reheated to 165 F then hot held to 135 F. See VC & D.
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Violation Description: All potentially hazardous food shall be RAPIDLY cooled from 135F to 70F, within 2 hours, and then from 70F to 41 F, within 4 hours. Cooling shall be by one or more of the following methods: in shallow containers; separating food into smaller portions; adding ice as an ingredient; using an ice bath; stirring frequently; using rapid cooling equipment; or, using containers that facilitate heat transfer. PHF is to be cooled within 4 hours to 41F if prepared from ingredients at ambient temperature. Deliveries of PHF is to be cooled to below 41F within 4 hours if received between 41F to 45F.

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 113947-113947.1	Inspector Comments: No manager certification available at this time. One person on site is to obtain a valid manager certification. Observed dishwasher unable to properly demonstrate the proper use of the three compartment sink and the manager was unaware of proper cooling methods for PHF items in the walk-in cooler. Food employees must be able to demonstrate food safety knowledge applicable to their assigned duties.
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Violation Description: All food employees shall have adequate knowledge of and be trained in food safety as it relates to their assigned duties. (113947) Food facilities that prepare, handle or serve non-prepackaged potentially hazardous food, shall have an employee who has passed an approved food safety certification examination. (113947-113947.1)

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Violation Description: All food shall be separated and protected from contamination. (113984 (a, b, c, d, f), 113986, 114060, 114067(a, d, e, j), 114069(a, b), 114077, 114089.1 (c), 114143 (c)) All food shall be stored, prepared, displayed or held so that it is protected from contamination.

34. WAREWASHING FACILITIES: INSTALLED, MAINTAINED, USED; TEST STRIPS

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified Complied on 4/27/2016 Violation Reference - HSC - 114067(f,g), 114099	Inspector Comments: Observed cooks line sanitizer bucket with over 300 ppm chlorine. Maintain sanitizer level at 100 ppm to 200 ppm.
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Violation Description: Food facilities that prepare food shall be equipped with warewashing facilities. Testing equipment and materials shall be provided to measure the applicable sanitization method. (114067(f,g), 114099, 114099.3, 114099.5, 114101(a), 114101.1, 114101.2, 114103, 114107, 114125) A thermometer must be readily available to monitor the temperature of the water at the warewashing sink. A warewashing sink used to wash wiping cloths, wash produce, or thaw food must be cleaned and sanitized before and after each use.

Repair the cooler doors to close properly. Observed soiled cook line refrigerator, walk-in cooler walls, walk-in fan guards, and walk-in shelving. Clean and maintain all equipment.

Violation Description: All utensils and equipment shall be fully operative and in good repair. (114175). All utensils and equipment shall be approved, installed properly, and meet applicable standards. Sanitizing towels to be kept in sanitizing solution when not in use. Observed one (1) sanitizer bucket with towels at the server area, without detectable sanitizer present. Maintain sanitizer level between 100 ppm to 200 ppm.
	Violation Reference - HSC - 114135, 114185.1	

Violation Description: Wiping cloths used to wipe service counters, scales or other surfaces that may come into contact with food shall be used only once unless kept in clean water with sanitizer. (114135, 114185.1, 114185.3 (d-e)) Sponges shall not be used in contact with cleaned and sanitized or in-use food contact surfaces. (114135)

POINTS 0	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance	Inspector Comments: Observed the following items at 43 F to 56 F in cooks line; 3/4 gallons pooled eggs, ten (10) quarts of cooked potatoes mingled with onions and peppers, two (2) pounds lunchmeat, five (5) quarts of cut watermelon, three (3) quarts of hollandaise sauce, one (1) pound of corned beef hash, one (1) pound of meatloaf. Observed the following items cooling at 44 F to 70n F in walk-in cooler; five (5) gallon drum of country gravy, and one (1) pot of chicken stock. Above items voluntarily discarded.
