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**7. PROPER HOT AND COLD HOLDING TEMPERATURES** **⚠ CRITICAL ⚠**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>4</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 113996, 113998, 114037	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed cooked shrimp at 52F, raw shrimp at 54F, pooled eggs at 57F in the refrigerator in the cook's line. Potentially hazardous food must be kept at or below 41F. Observed an ambient temperature of 52F in this unit.  Immediately repair refrigerator. These foods were discarded.  Observed eggs in the walkin at 49F. Whole eggs must be kept at or below 45F. Observed an ambient temperature of 44-45F in the walkin. Repair/adjust the walkin.
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**Violation Description:** Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41F or at or above 135F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a))

**9. PROPER COOLING METHODS** **⚠ CRITICAL ⚠**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>4</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114000	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed a deep metal container of chow mein cooling at 50-60F in the walkin. Chow mein was made yesterday.  These foods have been in the danger zone too long. Potentially hazardous food must be quickly cooled from 135F to 70F in 2 hours, 70F to 41F in 4 hours. This is accomplished by using ice baths, ice paddles, shallow stainless steel pans, portioning, blast chiller, etc. Obtain the necessary supplies. See handout.  This food was discarded. Cease using deep containers for cooling.
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**Violation Description:** All potentially hazardous food shall be RAPIDLY cooled from 135F to 70F, within 2 hours, and then from 70F to 41 F, within 4 hours. Cooling shall be by one or more of the following methods: in shallow containers; separating food into smaller portions; adding ice as an ingredient; using an ice bath; stirring frequently; using rapid cooling equipment; or, using containers that facilitate heat transfer. PHF is to be cooled within 4 hours to 41F if prepared from ingredients at ambient temperature. Deliveries of PHF is to be cooled to below 41F within 4 hours if received between 41F to 45F.

<b>POINTS</b> <b>2</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 113984(e), 114097, 114099	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Still observed that one compartment of the three compartment sink does not hold water as noted on previous inspection reports. Repair this sink and levers so equipment can be properly washed and sanitized.  Observed that equipment used constantly is not be washed and sanitized every 4 hours. Wash and sanitize this equipment every 4 hours.
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**Violation Description:** All food contact surfaces of utensils and equipment shall be clean and sanitized. (113984(e), 114097, 114099.1, 114099.4, 114099.6, 114101 (b-d), 114105, 114109, 114111, 114113, 114115 (a, b, d), 114117, 114125(b), 114135, 114141)

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 113984 (a, b, c, d, f)	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed uncovered food in the walkin. Obtain some foodgrade plastic bags to cover the food on the portable carts.
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**Violation Description:** All food shall be separated and protected from contamination. (113984 (a, b, c, d, f), 113986, 114060, 114067(a, d, e, j), 114069(a, b), 114077, 114089.1 (c), 114143 (c)) All food shall be stored, prepared, displayed or held so that it is protected from contamination.

**Violation Description:** All utensils and equipment shall be fully operative and in good repair. (114175). All utensils and equipment shall be approved, installed properly, and meet applicable standards. (114130, 114130.1, 114130.2, 114130.3, 114130.4, 114130.5, 114132, 114133, 114137, 114139, 114153, 114155, 114163, 114165, 114167, 114169, 114177, 114180, 114182)

**40. WIPING CLOTHS: PROPERLY USED AND STORED**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed the use of a dirty towel under cutting board and a piece of cardboard.
	Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114135, 114185.1	Cease using cardboard. Obtain a washable mat. Cease using dirty cloth towels. Obtain some new ones.

**Violation Description:** Wiping cloths used to wipe service counters, scales or other surfaces that may come into contact with food shall be used only once unless kept in clean water with sanitizer. (114135, 114185.1, 114185.3 (d-e)) Sponges shall not be used in contact with cleaned and sanitized or in-use food contact surfaces. (114135)

**41. PLUMBING; PROPER BACKFLOW DEVICES**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Repair the leaking three compartment utensil sink.
	Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114171, 114189.1	Repair the leaking wok.

**Violation Description:** The potable water supply shall be protected with a backflow or back siphonage protection device, as required by applicable plumbing codes. (114192) All plumbing and plumbing fixtures shall be installed in compliance with local plumbing ordinances, shall be maintained so as to prevent any contamination, and shall be kept clean, fully operative, and in good repair. Any hose used for conveying potable water shall be of approved materials, labeled, properly stored, and used for no other purpose. (114171, 114189.1, 114190, 114193, 114193.1, 114199, 114201, 114269)

**45. FLOORS, WALLS AND CEILINGS: BUILT, MAINTAINED, AND CLEAN**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed debris buildup on the ceiling panels. Clean the ceiling.
	Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114143 (d), 114266	

**Violation Description:** The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143 (d), 114257, 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272) Cleaning must be an approved dustless method. (114268.1) Mats and duckboards, if used, must be removable and easily cleanable. (114272) Open-air barbecues or wood-burning ovens floor surfaces must extend a minimum of five feet and be impervious or easily cleanable. (114143(d))
