Compliance Date: Not Specified **Inspector Comments:** Reinspection conducted on this day as a follow-up to complaint and routine inspections conducted 3/16/22. On that day permit was suspended and facility closed due to active infestation of rodents. Operator was advised to obtain pest control to remove rodents, and remove all evidence of rodents from facility. Operator was also advised to clean and sanitize all affected areas prior to reinspection.
Not In Compliance

During reinspection operator provided pest control invoice dated 3/18/22 stating facility was treated for rodents. Approximately 20 sticky traps were observed placed on floor against coving around interior perimeter of facility. No live or dead rodents were observed at time of reinspection. Pest control provided operator with additional sticky traps to use if needed prior to pest control returning. Pest control invoice stated pest control is to revisit facility 2-4 days from this date.

All rodent droppings were observed cleaned from all areas of floor and shelving. Shelving observed cleaned and sanitized. All holes observed during inspection observed sealed at time of reinspection.

No further action required. Permit reinstated (see permit reinstatement comment).

Description: Reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior inspection.

Reinspection conducted on this day. Permit reinstated due to elimination of vermin infestation.
