Inspector Comments: The purpose of this visit was to conduct a complaint investigation inspection.

NATURE OF COMPLAINT:

The complainant alleged that this facility is operating without a valid health permit and owner made improvement without approval from Environmental Health Services (EHS).

FINDING(S):

The manager was available on site at the time of this inspection. According to the manager this new owner and new business moved in on October 8th, 2019.

OBSERVATION(S):

Observed a new owner took over this food facility, and changed the menu from baking cake to rice soup bowl without first notifying San Bernardino County EHS. The manager contacted EHS on 12/11/19. Observed the following change were made without approval:

- 1) The front kitchen was completely removed
- 2) A brand new water heater was installed
- 3) A service window was added to the wall behind the cash register

The manager was informed that this facility was immediately closed due to:

- 1) Operating without a valid health permit
- 2) Removal of the front kitchen without approval
- 3) Previous business has been closed for more than 6 months.

An application for transfer of ownership was left and explain to the manager.
Plan shall be submitted to EHS as soon as possible.

RESULT(S):

Facility was immediately closed.

Facility shall remain closed until receive approval from EHS.

Failure to comply can result in billable reinspection with minimum charge of \$122.50 of 30 minutes minimum or further legal action.
