Inspector Comments: Reinspection was conducted on 9/21/2022 to verify compliance of elimination of vermin in facility.

During investigation, observed several live adult cock roaches on the walls and ceilings located near the employee restroom area. Observed several live adult and nymph cock roaches in between the cracks and crevices of shelves storing prepackaged foods. Observed several dead adult cock roaches on the floor of the customer service area and on the floor of the back of the facility near employee restrooms. (See violations 16C023)

Upon questioning, operator stated the facility was serviced by pest control on 9/14/2022. Pest control invoice was provided.

Clean and sanitize all affected areas and maintain the facility free from vermin.

Facility was observed to not be in compliance.

A billable reinspection will be conducted on 9/27/2022 to verify compliance of eliminating vermin from the facility. Failure to comply will result in a billable re-inspection of \$122.50 per half hour with a half hour minimum.

Description: Reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior inspection.
