

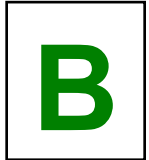

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**54. PERMIT SUSPENSION**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>0</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114409, 114405	<p><b>Inspector Comments:</b> The facility is hereby closed due to not having hot water. Observed the maximum hot water temperature to reach 93 degrees fahrenheit throughout the facility. Ensure to provide hot water of a minimum of 120 degrees fahrenheit at the facility. The facility is to remain closed until approval from environmental health has been granted. Note that if a new water heater is to be installed Plan check must be notify prior to installing to ensure it meets requirements. Contact plan check at (800) 442-2282.</p> <p>A closure sign has been posted. DO NOT REMOVE and or Relocate Closure sign. When ready for re-inspection, contact 800-442-2283</p>
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**Violation Description:** If an imminent health hazard is found, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility immediately closed. (114409, 114405)

**5. HANDS CLEAN AND PROPERLY WASHED; GLOVES USED PROPERLY** **MAJOR**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>4</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference -	<p><b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed employees wash hands with water measuring 95 degrees fahrenheit at a handwash sink located across the sushi line.</p> <p>Employees shall wash hands with soap and warm water of at least 100 degrees fahrenheit. The operator was educated on proper hand wash procedures.</p> <p>Note: The facility was observed to not have any hot water.</p> <p>Corrected on site. Operator was asked to close and stop the preparation of food.</p>
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**Violation Description:** Employees are required to wash their hands: before beginning work; before handling food / equipment / utensils; as often as necessary, during food preparation, to remove soil and contamination; when switching from working with raw to ready to eat foods, after touching body parts; after using toilet room; or any time when contamination may occur. Gloves shall be worn if an employee has cuts, wounds, fake nails, nail polish, and/or rashes. Gloves are to be used for no more than one task. Employees are not to wrap or package leftover food using bare hands or unclean utensils. Hand sanitizers may be used after proper hand washing. Employees handling food must have fingernails that are trimmed, cleanable, and smooth. (113952, 113953.3, 113953.4, 113961, 113968, 113973 (b-f))

**21. HOT AND COLD WATER AVAILABLE** **MAJOR**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>4</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 113953(c), 114099.2(b)	<p><b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed the temperature of the water to measure 93 degrees fahrenheit at the following sinks:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The mop sink</li> <li>- The 3-compartment sink</li> <li>- The preparation sink</li> <li>- All handwash sinks in the facility including the restrooms.</li> </ul> <p>Observed no hot water at the facility during time of inspection.</p> <p>Provide hot water water of a minimum of 120 degrees fahrenheit at the facility.</p> <p>The facility is hereby closed due to having no hot water in the facility. Note that if a new water heater is to be installed Plan check must be notify prior to installing to ensure it meets requirements. Contact plan check at (800) 442-2282.</p>
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**Violation Description:** An adequate, protected, pressurized, potable supply of hot water and cold water shall be provided at all times. (113953(c), 114099.2(b) 114101(a), 114189, 114192, 114192.1, 114195)



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**26. APPROVED THAWING METHODS USED, FROZEN FOOD**

POINTS <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114018, 114020, 114020.1	Inspector Comments: Observed 8 boxes of shrimp thawing at room temperature below the preparation table. According to the operator, the delivery of shrimp had arrived approximately 30 minutes prior to inspection.
		Ensure foods are thawed via the following methods: under refrigeration, completely submerged in cold (no higher than 70F), running water for less than 2 hours, in microwave, or during the cooking process.

**Violation Description:** Food shall be thawed under refrigeration; completely submerged under cold running water (less than 70F) of sufficient velocity to flush loose particles for less than 2 hours; in microwave oven; or during the cooking process. (114018, 114020, 114020.1)

**36. EQUIPMENT, UTENSILS AND LINENS: STORAGE AND USE**

POINTS <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114074, 114081, 114119	Inspector Comments: 1. Observed a pair of tongs to be stored on the handle of the cooking unit at the cook's line.  Store utensils in a sanitary manner.  2. Observed a pressurized tank in the dry food storage area to not be secured properly.  Fasten all pressurized cylinders to a rigid structure.
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**Violation Description:** All clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces. (114185.3 - 114185.4) Utensils and equipment shall be handled and stored so as to be protected from contamination. (114074 - 114075, 114081, 114119, 114121, 114161, 114178, 114179, 114083, 114185, 114185.2, 114185.5) Pressurized cylinders must be securely fastened to a rigid structure. (114172)

**40. WIPING CLOTHS: PROPERLY USED AND STORED**

POINTS <b>1</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114135, 114185.1	Inspector Comments: Observed multiple wet cloths stored directly on food preparation tables throughout the facility.  Maintain wet cloths submerged in sanitizer solution when not in use and or put away with soiled linen.
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**Violation Description:** Wiping cloths used to wipe service counters, scales or other surfaces that may come into contact with food shall be used only once unless kept in clean water with sanitizer. (114135, 114185.1, 114185.3 (d-e)) Sponges shall not be used in contact with cleaned and sanitized or in-use food contact surfaces. (114135)

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#### 48. FOOD HANDLER CERTIFICATION

POINTS <b>3</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed 1 missing food handler cards.  Fax or email missing food handler card form within 14 days to avoid a future charged follow-up inspection at an hourly rate of \$245. Note: Food handler cards MUST be issued by San Bernardino County to be valid.  Provided missing food handler card form.

**Violation Description:** This facility is currently in violation with the food handler certification requirement for San Bernardino County, which states all food handlers must obtain a valid food handler certificate within fourteen (14) days of employment (33.0410, 33.044). Failure to provide proof of food handler certification within fourteen (14) days will result in unannounced billable (at our current hourly rate) re-inspections to verify compliance.

#### IMPORTANT: Risk Based Inspection Frequency

Food facilities that pose a higher risk level for causing foodborne illness will be subject to an additional inspection, to be billed at the hourly rate as provided in the San Bernardino County Code [Schedule of Fees](#). Facilities that received one or more of the following will be elevated to a high risk tier:

- A score letter of "C" or lower on one of the last two graded inspections,
- A score letter of "B" on two of the last three graded inspections,
- Repeated "four (4) point violation Risk Factor" (critical violation codes 1-23) on the last two inspections, or
- Four (4) or more critical violations (codes 1-23) noted during an inspection, or
