Inspector Comments: This billable re-inspection is being conducted at the request of the operator.

This facility was closed for business at the time of this inspection.

On 03/03/2021, the health permit for this facility was suspended due to a cockroach infestation. On this date, after a thorough inspection of the entire kitchen facility, observed two (2) dead and merely dead nymph cockroaches, but no live evidence of cockroaches.

The owner provided recent professional exterminator receipts showing pest control service at this facility on 03/04/2021.

This food facility was observed to be in a clean and sanitary condition.

The health permit for this facility was re-instated this date. The notice of closure sign was removed this date.

Continue to maintain this facility in a clean and sanitary condition and free from vermin-including but not limited to cockroaches.

Description: The health permit to operate is hereby reinstated and facility may open.

Inspector Comments: This 2nd reinspection was requested by the operator. This is a billable re-inspection.

The health permit for this facility was suspended on 03/03/2021 due to a cockroach infestation in the food facility. Observed several live cockroaches throughout the kitchen area on 03/04/2021 so this food facility was remained closed.

On this date, after thorough inspection of this food facility, observed two (2) dead and merely dead nymph cockroaches on the floor behind the ice cream machine in the kitchen. Observed no other dead or live cockroaches at the time of this re-inspection.

The owner provided recent pest control report that mentioned this food facility was treated on Thursday, 03/04/2021, 08:07 AM with microgen and the roaches will decrease for next 7 days and will return on Wednesday, 03/10/2021, to do a follow up inspection and treatment if necessary.

Ensure to take appropriate pest control measures to eliminate all evidence of past or current vermin from this facility including but not limited to cockroaches. Clean and sanitize affected area in an approved manner. Ensure to enclose all cracks, crevices, holes, and gaps in this food facility.

A supervisor review is scheduled on Wednesday 03/10/2021 at 9 AM in the Rancho Cucamonga office located on 8575 Haven Ave. Rancho Cucamonga. Provide any pest control receipts/ reports to the review.

A one (1) week follow-up billable re-inspection is scheduled on Friday, 03/12/2021, to determine compliance. Non-compliance will result in the health permit suspension and the facility closure.

Observed this food facility was closed and the notice of closure sign remained posted at the front window at the time of inspection. The notice of closure sign was removed, and letter grade "B" was posted on the window next to the entrance.

Do not remove, relocate, or obscure from public view. Non-compliance will result in a billable follow-up re-inspection at an hourly rate of \$245 with a minimum charge of \$122.50.

Description: Billable re-inspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior reinspection.
