Our department received a complaint of a live and dead German roaches in the ice cream freezer area. Observed dead German roaches in the ice cream freezer area at the time of inspection. Immediately take effective steps to eliminate roaches and other vermin from the facility.

The owner stated that the facility is being treated and maintained for roaches and other vermin once every month by the Antmart Pest Management company.

Observed receipts of services dated 6/18/19, 5/15/19, and 4/15/19.
