Inspector Comments: The purpose of this visit was to provide information and conduct a survey regarding COVID-19.

FINDING(S):

The manager stated the following:

- Did not know the location of the "B" letter grade card.
- The previous inspector did not post any of the three letter grades.
- Does not have the "B" letter grade card posted at the facility due to not liking the way it looks.
- Ordered a hood to be installed soon in the deli kitchen, in the preparation area to the left of the kitchen entrance.
- All relevant departments/individuals have already been notified of the hood installation plan.

OBSERVATION(S):

- Observed two "A" letter grade cards posted. One card posted at the prepackaged area (letter grade for the prepackaged permit) and one posted at the deli kitchen (letter grade for the bakery permit).
- The "B" letter grade card not visible/posted anywhere in the facility.
- The most recent inspection report (2/18/20) states that the "B" letter grade card was not visible and that a new card was posted. The report also states to not remove, relocate, or move the letter grade card and that non-compliance will result in a billable follow-up inspection.
- The manager retrieved the "B" letter grade card from her office at the time of inspection.
- EHS Plan check was not notified of the facility's plan to install a hood in the deli kitchen and did not receive plans from this facility.

RESULT(S):

- Posted the "B" letter grade card at the entrance of the deli kitchen and relocated the bakery letter grade card to the bakery.
 - DO NOT REMOVE, OBSTRUCT IN ANY WAY, OR RELOCATE THE LETTER GRADE CARD.
- Non-compliance will result in a charged follow-up inspection at an hourly rate of \$245. When ready for re-inspection, submit a re-score inspection application.
- A person proposing to build or remodel a food facility shall submit plans to EHS Plan Check for approval before starting any new construction or remodeling of any facility for use as a retail food facility. Contact San Bernardino County, Division of Environmental Health Services - Plan Check Department for remodeling inquiries at - 1-(800)-442-2283. Please refer to the Retail Food Facility Construction Guide.

Inspector Comments: Observed missing "B" letter grade card for the deli kitchen. The manager stated that she does not like the way the letter grade card looks posted in the facility.

Letter Grade Placard shall be properly posted.

Note: The manager retrieved the grade card from her office at the time of inspection. The grade card was posted at the entrance of the deli kitchen on this date. Corrected on site.

Violation Description: Handwashing signs shall be posted in each toilet room, directing attention to the need to thoroughly wash hands after using the restroom (113953.5) (b) No smoking signs shall be posted in food preparation, food storage, warewashing, and utensil storage areas (113978). (c) Consumers shall be notified that clean tableware is to be used when they return to self-service areas such as salad bars and buffets. (d) Any food facility constructed before January 1, 2004 without public toilet facilities, shall prominently post a sign within the food facility in a public area stating that toilet facilities are not provided (113725.1, 114381 (e)). A sign shall be posted stating that a copy of the most recent routine inspection report is available upon request. (113725.1) Permit shall be posted in conspicuous location. (114381(e)) Letter Grade Placard shall be properly posted. SBCC 33.1406
