Inspector Comments:

On this date a re-reinspection was conducted to verify compliance with a rodent infestation observed at this facility during the last routine inspection.

At this time inspector observed fresh droppings beneath bulk ice machine and throughout bakery area. Refer to violation 16K023.

Most recent pest control report was reviewed at this time. As per report dated 12/6/18, rodent activity was noted. Highly recommend to continue with receiving pest control treatment.

Description: Billable re-reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior reinspection.

Inspector Comments:

Observed rodent droppings in the following areas:

- Underneath bulk-ice machine in back dry storage area of facility
- Beneath both stainless steel preparation tables adjacent to bakery cooking equipment
- Beneath wooden preparation table where bulk containers of flour and sugar are stored in the bakery
- On the floor near corner where pie over is located
- Beneath pie hot holding unit near north west pie service area.

Remove all rodent droppings from facility. Thoroughly clean and sanitize affected areas.

Ensure to maintain facility free of vermin (rodents) at all times.

At this time a billable follow-up inspection will be conducted within 5-business days to verify rodent issue has been abated.

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. (114259.4, 114259.5)

16K036 Equipment, utensils and linens: storage and use

Inspector Comments:

Observe one (1) superior three door upright freezer stored directly outside facility, near bakery back exit. At this time pie shells and ice cream are being stored in the unit.

Ensure all equipment and utensils are stored inside the permitted food facility to prevent possible contamination.

Relocate or remove equipment.

Violation Description: All clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces. (114185.3 - 114185.4) Utensils and equipment shall be handled and stored so as to be protected from contamination. (114074 - 114075, 114081, 114119, 114121, 114161, 114178, 114179, 114083, 114185, 114185.2, 114185.5) Pressurized cylinders must be securely fastened to a rigid structure. (114172)

Overall Inspection Comments

A billable re-reinspection will be conducted on a later date to verify compliance with rodent activity.
