Place and maintain an adequate amount of paper towels in approved dispensers for every hand wash location. Corrected on site: Employee placed paper towels on paper towel dispenser.
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Violation Description: Handwashing soap and towels or drying device shall be provided in dispensers; dispensers shall be maintained in good repair. (113953.2) Adequate facilities shall be provided for hand washing. (113953, 113953.1, 114067(f)). Handwashing sink is not separated from a warewashing sink by a 6 inch high metal splashguard or 24 inch separation. (113953) Handwashing sinks shall not be obstructed, inaccessible, used improperly or kept unclean. (113953.1)

7. PROPER HOT AND COLD HOLDING TEMPERATURES

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified Complied on 11/22/2019 Violation Reference - HSC - 113996, 113998, 114037	Inspector Comments: Measured the following internal temperatures for potentially hazardous food products stored in wooden compartment located inside the walk in cooler: - Turkey Breast at 46 F, Roast beef at 48 F, and Pastrami at 48 F. According to owner, the food items mentioned above were placed in the unit since yesterday. Maintain all potentially hazardous foods at 41 F or below / 135 F or above. Corrected on site: Owner agreed to refuse the food items mentioned above.
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Violation Description: Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41F or at or above 135F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a))

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 113984 (a, b, c, d, f)	Inspector Comments: 1) Observed one tray of spinach stored directly touching tray of lettuce at the preparation refrigerator. 2) Observed tray of bacon without lid stored above the preparation refrigerator. Maintain food stored, prepared, displayed, or held so that it is protected from cross-contamination (e.g., sneeze guards, lids, display cases, dispensers, and labeled containers separating raw food from RTE food.).
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Violation Description: All food shall be separated and protected from contamination. (113984 (a, b, c, d, f), 113986, 114060, 114067(a, d, e, j), 114069(a, b), 114077, 114089.1 (c), 114143 (c)) All food shall be stored, prepared, displayed or held so that it is protected from contamination.

30. FOOD STORAGE; FOOD STORAGE CONTAINERS IDENTIFIED

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114047, 114049, 114051	Inspector Comments: 1) Observed numerous bottles on food liquids and powders without labels throughout facility. Provide labels for containers of food or ingredients that have been removed from original packages and/or are not easily recognizable (except food that can be easily recognized e.g., pasta, rice, or beans). 2) Observed bottles of peanut oil and olive oil stored directly on floor. Ensure that all food and equipment is stored at least 6 inches above floor.
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Violation Description: Food shall be stored in approved containers and labeled as to contents. Food shall be stored at least 6" above the floor on approved shelving in an approved location to prevent possible contamination. (114047, 114049, 114051, 114053, 114055, 114067(h), 14069 (b))

Clean and maintain all non food contact areas clean at all times.
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Violation Description: All nonfood contact surfaces of utensils and equipment shall be clean. (114115 (c))

34. WAREWASHING FACILITIES: INSTALLED, MAINTAINED, USED; TEST STRIPS

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114067(f,g), 114099	Inspector Comments: Observed quaternary ammonium sanitizer test strips missing from facility. Obtain and maintain an adequate amount of sanitizer test strips available at facility.
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Violation Description: Food facilities that prepare food shall be equipped with warewashing facilities. Testing equipment and materials shall be provided to measure the applicable sanitization method. (114067(f,g), 114099, 114099.3, 114099.5, 114101(a), 114101.1, 114101.2, 114103, 114107, 114125) A thermometer must be readily available to monitor the temperature of the water at the warewashing sink. A warewashing sink used to wash wiping cloths, wash produce, or thaw food must be cleaned and sanitized before and after each use.

Repair or replace the gasket and maintain all equipment in good repair.
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Violation Description: All utensils and equipment shall be fully operative and in good repair. (114175). All utensils and equipment shall be approved, installed properly, and meet applicable standards. (114130, 114130.1, 114130.2, 114130.3, 114130.4, 114130.5, 114132, 114133, 114137, 114139, 114153, 114155, 114163, 114165, 114167, 114169, 114177, 114180, 114182)

Discontinue this practice, ensure to store utensils in clean and sanitary areas. Corrected on site: Owner moved plates to sanitary location. 2) Observed two(2) empty CO2 cylinder and one (1) full CO2 stored directly on floor without chains or All pressurized cylinders shall be securely fastened to a rigid structure.
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Violation Description: All clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces. (114185.3 - 114185.4) Utensils and equipment shall be handled and stored so as to be protected from contamination. (114074 - 114075, 114081, 114119, 114121, 114161, 114178, 114179, 114083, 114185, 114185.2, 114185.5) Pressurized cylinders must be securely fastened to a rigid structure. (114172)

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114157, 114159	<p>Inspector Comments: 1) Observed thermometers missing from the two (2) preparation refrigerators used for storing ham.</p> <p>Place and maintain working thermometers for all refrigeration units used for storing potentially hazardous foods.</p> <p>2) Observed no probe thermometer in facility.</p> <p>Obtain and maintain working probe thermometers in facility.</p>
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Violation Description: An accurate easily readable metal probe thermometer suitable for measuring temperature of food shall be available to the food handler. A thermometer +/- 2 F shall be provided for each hot and cold holding unit of potentially hazardous foods and high temperature warewashing machines. (114157, 114159)

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114067 (j), 114123	<p>Inspector Comments: Observed one (1) hole on door located in back storage room and two (2) small holes on ceiling located above the dry storage hall in the deli area.</p> <p>Seal and maintain all unapproved openings sealed to prevent vermin entrance.</p>
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Violation Description: The premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish; all clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces; the facility shall be kept vermin proof. (114067 (j), 114123, 114143 (a) & (b), 114256, 114256.1, 114256.2, 114256.4, 114257, 114257.1, 114259, 114259.2, 114259.3, 114279, 114281, 114282) Food preparation sinks, handwashing sinks and warewashing equipment shall not be used for the cleaning of maintenance tools, the holding of maintenance materials, or the disposal of liquid wastes. (114123) Open-air barbecue and/or outdoor wood burning oven must operate on the same premises, in conjunction with a permanent food facility and not in an area that may pose as a fire hazard. (114143(a) (b)) Janitorial sink or approved curbed cleaning facility (exemption for restricted food service facilities Section 114279 (b)) shall be provided. (114279(a)) First aid supplies must have a legible manufacturer's label and stored in a kit or container that is located to prevent contamination. (114256.4) Insect electrocution devices are not allowed in food or utensil handling areas. (114259.3)

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114143 (d), 114266	<p>Inspector Comments: 1) Observed paint chipping from wooden compartment located above the 3-compartment sink.</p> <p>2) Observed moderate grease build up on walls located next to flat grill in kitchen.</p> <p>Repair and maintain all floors, walls, and ceilings clean in good repair.</p>
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Violation Description: The walls / ceilings shall have durable, smooth, nonabsorbent, and washable surfaces. All floor surfaces, other than the customer service areas, shall be approved, smooth, durable and made of nonabsorbent material that is easily cleanable. Approved base coving shall be provided in all areas, except customer service areas and where food is stored in original unopened containers. Food facilities shall be fully enclosed. All food facilities shall be kept clean and in good repair. (114143 (d), 114257, 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272) Cleaning must be an approved dustless method. (114268.1) Mats and duckboards, if used, must be removable and easily cleanable. (114272) Open-air barbecues or wood-burning ovens floor surfaces must extend a minimum of five feet and be impervious or easily cleanable. (114143(d))

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Violation Description: A person proposing to build or remodel a food facility shall submit plans for approval before starting any new construction or remodeling of any facility for use as a retail food facility. (114380)

Observed ceiling fan located above the dry storage hall and flat grill with excessive dust build up.

Clean and maintain all non food contact surfaces clean.

On this date a "B" grade card was posted. For a B grade (score of 80 to 89) A re-score inspection may be requested by a food facility who receives a "B" grade after the completion of an official routine inspection. This request is optional on the part of the facility which may wish to try to improve their score or letter grade. The Health Official will complete the re-score inspection within ten (10) County business days of the food facility submitting a request for a re-score inspection. The inspection rate is \$245.00 per hour. A minimum of \$122.50 will be charged for the first 30 minutes of inspection time. A Letter Grade Card shall remain valid until the Health Official completes the next routine inspection or re-score inspection of the food facility. A re-score inspection is a new, unscheduled, complete routine inspection that a) may be required by County Ordinance; or b) may be requested by the food facility.
