Inspector Comments: Re-reinspection conducted on this day as follow-up to closure during routine inspection conducted 12/9/19. On that day, facility was observed to have active rodent infestation. Owner was advised to discard all contaminated food, obtain pest control and provide receipts/invoices, repair/correct all possibilities of vermin entry areas, and clean and sanitize all food and nonfood-contact surfaces.

Per owner's request, reinspection conducted 12/16/19 to verify compliance from routine inspection. On that day, rodent droppings still observed throughout facility, including where food/drinks are stored. Owner was again instructed to discard any contaminated food, repair/correct all possibilities of vermin entry areas, and thoroughly clean and sanitize all food and nonfood-contact surfaces. Owner was also advised to submit video and pictures of all areas previously contaminated, which was done 12/17/19 and 12/18/19. Owner was then given verbal permission via text messaging over phone 12/18/19 to reopen and operate, to be later visited by inspector for verification during re-reinspection.

During re-reinspection, all rodent droppings observed cleaned from all areas previously contaminated. No evidence of active infestation observed. No further action required at this time.

Description: Billable re-reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior reinspection.
