Observed exposed insulation material and damaged roof/ceiling in the prep area. Photos taken. The District Manager stated that all contaminated foods were thrown away.

The facility is hereby ordered closed and the permit to operate is suspended until the damaged roof/ceiling is repaired. Prior to reopening for business, thoroughly clean and sanitize all equipment, utensils, floor, and walls in the affected area. Obtain a clearance inspection from the Fire Department.
