**Inspector Comments: PURPOSE:**  
A re-inspection was conducted on this date per the operators request.

**NATURE OF THE RE-INSPECTION:**

A re-inspection was conducted on this date to determine compliance with violations observed during a complaint investigation which was conducted on 3/12/2021. It was noted during this inspection that facility contained an active rodent infestation. It was also noted that rodent droppings were observed, amongst various candies offered for customer sale, underneath shelving in the customer service area and Hershey candies were observed to be chewed open and adulterated. The facility was subsequently closed and permit was temporarily suspended.

**OBSERVATION:**

After a thorough search of the facility, observed no signs of an active rodent infestation. Observed no rodent droppings or adulterated food caused by an active rodent infestation. The operator was able to provide daily pest control receipts dating from 3/14/2021 to 3/17/2021.

**OUTCOME:**

The facility is hereby reopened and the health permit reinstated on this date. A billed follow up inspection will be conducted after seven (7) days to observe continued compliance. Failure to comply may result in additional billed follow up inspections or possible permit suspension.
