Inspector Comments: Our department received a complaint that an elderly handicapped woman, accompanied by her son, had an 'accident' on herself and the son was not able to access the handicap restroom to clean her up until he called the police. The management is already aware of the complaint. The manager on duty, Sandy, stated that the complainant who was a man, was taking her mom to the men restroom that was locked either because somebody was using it or it was locked by small kids playing around. She stated that she told the complainant that the stall door could not be locked from outside. She stated that she told the complainant that she was going to have the door open when all men in the restroom are out because as a woman she could not go in there when men are there.

At the time of inspection, the handicap restrooms are available and accessible for use by customers.
