Inspector Comments: Observed cooked pork carnitas (47F-48F), cooked chicken (48F-49F), tripe soup (47F-48F), shredded beef (47F-48F) and carne al pastor (47F-48F). holding out of temperature in upright refrigeration unit in kitchen.
 Operator could not identify length of time foods item were out of temperature. Date stamp indicated foods items produced one day prior to inspection (1/28/15).

Maintain all potentially hazardous foods held cold at 41F or below.

Correction: Observed operator voluntarily discard out of temperature items. See VC&D.

Violation Description: Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41F or at or above 135F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a))
