Inspector Comments: A scheduled follow up reinspection was conducted on this date to ensure this facility is free from vermin-including but not limited to-cockroaches. On this date, the following cockroach activity was observed in the following areas:

- 1) Observed one live adult cockroach on the upper wall above the three compartment sink.
- 2) Observed one live adult cockroach on the bottom part of the small table located next to the three compartment sink.
- 3) Observed one live nymph cockroach on the floor below the microwave.
- 4) Observed one live two nymph cockroaches on the crevice below the stainless steel wall below the kitchen hand sink.
- 5) Observed one dying adult cockroach below the reach-in refrigerator.

-In addition, observed dead cockroaches throughout the kitchen floors, one dead cockroach inside the stove, one dead cockroach on the floor in the mens' restroom, three dead cockroaches in the light fixture located above the three compartment sink, and dead cockroaches stuck to the wall in the dry storage room.

Note: The front and rear kitchen doors were observed open during this inspection. Ensure doors are maintained closed to prevent the entrance of vermin. Continue sealing any cracks/ crevices that can harbor vermin: (ex: observed open crevices on the lower walls at the cooks line and below the kitchen hand sink.). Eliminate all vermin and evidence of vermin from this food facility. The health permit was suspended on this date due to a live cockroach infestation observed in the kitchen facility.

Description: Reinspection conducted at this time to determine compliance from prior inspection.

Violation Reference - HSC - 114409, 114405

Inspector Comments: The health permit to this facility was suspended this date due to a live cockroach infestation that was observed in the kitchen facility.

Several live adult and nymph cockroaches were observed throughout kitchen facility. The operator was unable to produce recent pest control reports/ receipts but stated service was conducted on 12/09/2018. Continue conducting proper exclusion methods to ensure this infestation is completely eliminated. Clean and sanitize all affected areas.

Call this office when you are ready to re-open and re-reinspection will be conducted to determine compliance.

Note: Any reinspection conducted after this date shall be conducted at a billable rate of \$245/hr with a half an hour minimum charge of \$122.50.

This facility must remain closed for business until a re-reinspection is conducted and the health permit to operate this facility is reinstated by a representative of this agency.

Violation Description: If an imminent health hazard is found, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility immediately closed. (114409, 114405)

Inspector Comments: Observed several live adult and nymph cockroaches throughout the kitchen facility. In addition, dead cockroaches were observed on the floors and walls throughout the kitchen facility. Eliminate all vermin and evidence of vermin from this facility including but not limited to cockroaches.

Violation Description: Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. (114259.4, 114259.5)

Overall Inspection Comments

Note Letter grade C was covered and it was unable to be seen due to a large 'OPEN' sign that was covering the letter grade. Discontinue this practice. Letter grade C was removed and Notice of Closure sign was posted on this date.
