**Inspector Comments:** A re-reinspection was conducted on this date.

During a routine inspection on 11/04/2021 and follow up inspection 11/05/2021, it was noted on reports of rodent droppings and adulterated food with chew marks on the prepackaged food items.

Observations on this date:

- No rodent droppings in the food storage area.
- No adulterated chewed up prepackaged food items in the facility.
- Numerous holes in the back storage area to be sealed off with foam.
- Person in charge stated pest control service conducted with Terminix on this date.

A follow up inspection will be conducted on or after 11/15/2021 for a maintenance of facility check due to the closure on 11/04/2021. Non-compliance may result to future billable re inspections. The facility operator may be required to report to a Supervisory Meeting at Environmental Health Services (San Bernardino office).
