



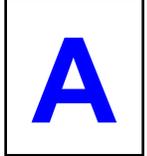

**5. HANDS CLEAN AND PROPERLY WASHED; GLOVES USED PROPERLY ⚠ CRITICAL ⚠**

<b>POINTS</b> <b>4</b>	Compliance date not specified Complied on 7/29/2015 Violation Reference -	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed employee handle change at register then proceed to grab and don gloves to prepare sandwich without washing hands in between.  Each time new gloves are donned to initially begin working with food, employees are required to wash and dry hands prior to putting on gloves.  Corrective action: Employee removed gloves and washed hands before putting on new gloves.
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**Violation Description:** Employees are required to wash their hands: before beginning work; before handling food / equipment / utensils; as often as necessary, during food preparation, to remove soil and contamination; when switching from working with raw to ready to eat foods, after touching body parts; after using toilet room; or any time when contamination may occur. Gloves shall be worn if an employee has cuts, wounds, fake nails, nail polish, and/or rashes. Gloves are to be used for no more than one task. Employees are not to wrap or package leftover food using bare hands or unclean utensils. Hand sanitizers may be used after proper hand washing. Employees handling food must have fingernails that are trimmed, cleanable, and smooth. (113952, 113953.3, 113953.4, 113961, 113968, 113973 (b-f))

Obtain at least one food manager certificate from an accredited organization that has been certified by the American National Standards Institute (ANSI). Provide manager's certificate at facility within 30 days. Non-compliance will result in a future charged inspection at an hourly rate of \$245.  Note: Original certificate must be available at facility in order to be valid.
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**Violation Description:** All food employees shall have adequate knowledge of and be trained in food safety as it relates to their assigned duties. (113947) Food facilities that prepare, handle or serve non-prepackaged potentially hazardous food, shall have an employee who has passed an approved food safety certification examination. Ensure all potentially hazardous foods in cold holding are kept at 41F or below.
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**Violation Description:** Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41F or at or above 135F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a))

<b>POINTS</b> <b>2</b>	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - SBCC - 33.0409	<b>Inspector Comments:</b> Observed 1 missing food worker cards. Fax missing food handler card form within 14 days to avoid a future charged follow-up inspection at an hourly rate of \$245. Note: Food worker cards MUST be issued by San Bernardino County to be valid.
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**Violation Description:** This facility is currently in violation with the food handler certification requirement for San Bernardino County, which states all food handlers must obtain a valid food handler certificate within fourteen (14) days of employment (33.0410, 33.044). Failure to provide proof of food handler certification within fourteen (14) days will result in unannounced billable (at our current hourly rate) re-inspections to verify compliance.
