Metal container was not fully submerged in ice. PIC stated that the beef was place in the unit approximately 4 hours prior. Corrected on site. PIC voluntarily discarded of beef. See VC &D. Ensure that all cold holding foods are maintained at or below 41F.
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Violation Description: Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41F or at or above 135F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a))

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114074, 114081, 114119	Inspector Comments: Observed plastic cups with no handles being used as food scoops in dry storage containers. Discontinue the use of food scoops without handles. Ensure that all food scoops have handles to prevent contamination by hands.
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Violation Description: All clean and soiled linen shall be properly stored; non-food items shall be stored and displayed separate from food and food-contact surfaces. (114185.3 - 114185.4) Utensils and equipment shall be handled and stored so as to be protected from contamination. (114074 - 114075, 114081, 114119, 114121, 114161, 114178, 114179, 114083, 114185, 114185.2, 114185.5) Pressurized cylinders must be securely fastened to a rigid structure. (114172)

38. ADEQUATE VENTILATION AND LIGHTING; DESIGNATED AREA

POINTS 1	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - HSC - 114149, 114149.1	Inspector Comments: Observed large gaps in vents under hood above wok area. Avoid gaps in vents in order to prevent fire hazards.
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Violation Description: Exhaust hoods shall be provided to remove toxic gases, heat, grease, vapors and smoke and be approved by the local building department. Canopy-type hoods shall extend 6" beyond all cooking equipment. All areas shall have sufficient ventilation to facilitate proper food storage. Toilet rooms shall be vented to the outside air by a screened openable window, an air shaft, or a light-switch activated exhaust fan, consistent with local building codes. (114149, 114149.1) Adequate lighting shall be provided in all areas to facilitate cleaning and inspection. Light fixtures in areas where open food is stored, served, prepared, and where utensils are washed shall be of shatterproof construction or protected with light shields. (114149.2, 114149.3, 114252, 114252.1)

48. FOOD WORKER CERTIFICATION

POINTS 2	Compliance date not specified Not In Compliance Violation Reference - SBCC - 33.0410, 33.044	Inspector Comments: Observed 1 employees without valid San Bernardino County food worker cards. Ensure that employees maintain valid San Bernardino County food worker cards. Employees must provide a current food worker card within 14 days. There will be a re-inspection charge of \$245.00 per hour if current food worker card information is not faxed to the Division of Environmental health Services at 909-387-4272 on or before 5/1/15.
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Violation Description: This facility is currently in violation with the food worker certification requirement for San Bernardino County, which states all food workers must obtain a valid food worker certificate within fourteen (14) days of employment (33.0410, 33.044). Failure to provide proof of food worker certification within fourteen (14) days will result in unannounced billable (at our current hourly rate) re-inspections to verify compliance.
