Inspector Comments: (REPEAT) Observed old and fresh rodent droppings on numerous shelves containing food throughout facility. This includes shelves that contain a variety of potato chips, beef jerky, sunflower seeds, and on shelves beneath enclosed alcohol. Excessive rodent droppings observed on shelf containing bags of charcoal and in boxes containing prepackaged noodles. Observed noticeable musty/urine smell in area where excessive droppings are located. Gnawed bags of charcoal and gnawed bag of sunflower seeds half eaten, with sunflower seeds spilled onto shelves observed. Numerous live adult cockroaches observed on sticky traps on floor beneath shelves and ice machine in storage area in rear of facility. Clean and sanitize floors/walls, and all food and nonfood-contact surfaces. Discard all food that has been contaminated/adulterated by vermin.

Observed front door of facility not able to completely close; light seen through door. Repair weather stripping on door to prevent possible vermin entry.

Debris, dust, trash observed on floor beneath shelves in rear of facility. Dried liquid observed of floor beneath wine racks. Ceiling tile in front of facility observed in disrepair, and ceiling tiles in rear of facility observed missing. Clean and maintain floors, walls, and ceiling to prevent vermin attraction and/or entry.

Sunflower seeds and chips observed loose on shelf. Clean and maintain nonfood contact surfaces to prevent vermin attraction.

Eliminate vermin in facility, and take preventative measures to prevent vermin entry. At time of inspection, operator contacted pest control service to treat facility for vermin. Pest control service scheduled for 2:30 pm today, 4/6/17. Operator stated she is going to sign contract with pest control to service facility monthly.

**Violation Description:** Food facility shall be kept free of vermin: rodents (rats, mice), cockroaches, flies. (114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5) Live animals are not allowed in a food facility unless, food employees with service animals may handle or care for their service animal if they wash their hands as required or persons who are licensed pursuant to Chapter 11.5 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code. (114259.4, 114259.5)

### 16K022 Sewage and wastewater properly disposed

**Inspector Comments:** Observed toilet in toilet facility not properly functional; waste water not flushed. Ensure sewage does not back up from toilet, and toilet is operable at all times.

Violation Description: All liquid waste must drain to an approved fully functioning sewage disposal system. (114197) Toilet facilities must be operable.

Inspector Comments: Observed bags of litter stored on ground behind exterior trash container. Ensure exterior of facility is maintained free of litter and rubbish to prevent vermin attraction. Operator stated exterior trash containers are utilized by all facilities located in plaza. Trash pick up 3 times per week according to operator.

**Violation Description:** All food waste and rubbish shall be kept in leak proof and rodent proof containers. Containers shall be covered at all times. All waste must be removed and disposed of as frequently as necessary to prevent a nuisance. The exterior premises of each food facility shall be kept clean and free of litter and rubbish. (114244, 114245.1, 114245.1, 114245.2, 114245.3, 114245.5, 114245.6, 114245.7, 114245.8)
