16K997 Foodborne Illness Complaint Inspection

Inspector Comments: On this date a complaint investigation was conducted in regards to a possible food borne illness case received by this department, the San Bernardino County Division of Environmental Health Services.

Complainant states after consuming chow mein and orange chicken from this establishment, they became ill experiencing symptoms of diarrhea, chills, headache and fatigue. Complainant also advises that a family member also became ill after consuming the exact same food items.

At the time of inspection manager was made aware of the nature of this visit and stated no knowledge of such complaint.

Upon interview the following was discussed with manager:

- Employees have not reported any illnesses or observed to have signs of illness.
- No recent experiences with equipment malfunctions, plumbing issues or power outages at the facility.

The following holding temperatures were observed:

- Spicy orange chicken measuring between 105.8- 128.4 degrees F stored in hot holding display case (See violation 16K007)
- Traditional orange chicken to be measuring between 115.4- 130.8 degrees F stored in hot holding display case (See violation 16K007)
- Chow mein noodles measuring at 164.9 degrees stored in hot holding display case
- Raw chicken used for orange chicken to be measuring at 38 degrees F stored in cold holding unit across from cooks line
- Chow mein noodles stored in walk refrigerator to be measuring at 40 degrees F

Observed all sinks within the facility able to provide at least 120 degree F of hot water.

Observed sanitizing solution provided at three compartment sink measuring at 100 parts per million chlorine.

A thorough interview was completed on food safety knowledge and practices at this food facility.

Description: A foodborne illness complaint report has been received by Environmental Health.

16K007 Proper hot and cold holding temperatures

Inspector Comments:

The following holding temperatures were observed:

- 16 oz. Spicy orange chicken measuring between 105.8- 128.4 degrees F
- 16 oz. Traditional orange chicken to be measuring between 115.4- 130.8 degrees F

Ensure potentially hazardous foods are held at 41 degrees F or below when cold holding or 135 degrees F or above when hot holding.

Corrected on site: The above items were voluntarily removed and discarded (see VC & D).

Violation Description: Potentially hazardous foods shall be held at or below 41F or at or above 135F. (113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a))
