## Free Dump Day Planned for Mentone Area

SAN BERNARDINO, CA – In conjunction with San Bernardino County Code Enforcement and the Solid Waste Management Division, Supervisor Neil Derry is sponsoring a community clean-up day in the Mentone area from 8 a.m. to noon on Saturday, Aug. 8<sup>th</sup>. Unincorporated county residents wishing to take advantage of the free trash and tire collection containers may visit the collection site, which will be located at Redlands East Valley High School.

**“This is a great opportunity for residents to clean up their neighborhoods,”** Supervisor Derry said.

Although hazardous materials such as used motor oil, pesticides and paint products will not be accepted, residents will also be allowed to drop off their e-waste related to old televisions, computers and other electronic devices.
