## The Position

The County of San Bernardino seeks a **Public Health Medical Director** to plan, organize, direct, and coordinate medical services provided by the Department of Public Health.

The essential functions of the Medical Director are to:

- oversee the delivery of medical care to all patients, including appropriate evaluation, diagnoses, treatment, medical screening, and administration of medication.
- supervise, evaluate, and determine competency of medical staff.
