**SUBJECT:** **ACTIVATION OF LOMA LINDA UNIVERSITY MEDICAL CENTER AS AN ICEMA NEUROVASCULAR STROKE RECEIVING CENTERS (NSRC)**

We are pleased to announce that effective January 26, 2012, at 8:00 am, Loma Linda University Medical Center (LLUMC) has been designated as a Level I Neurovascular Stroke Receiving Centers (NSRC) for ICEMA.

LLUMC is located at 11234 Anderson Street, Loma Linda, CA 92354. LLUMC's Stroke contact nurse is Joanna Yang at (909) 558-4907.

Per Reference #6100 - Stroke "NSRC" Receiving Centers:

- e. NSRC Base Station contact is **mandatory** for all patients identified as a possible stroke patient.
- f. The NSRC base station is the only authority that can direct a patient to a NSRC. The destination may be changed at NSRC base station discretion.

**EMS providers with extended transport times to NSRC must make early contact with NSRC base station for destination decision.** NSRC base stations will be responsible for contacting paramedic receiving hospitals if the patient is not transported to a NSRC.
