## BASE STATION STATISTICS POLICY

**Effective July 1, 2009**

1. Base Stations to provide required data utilizing Excel spreadsheet approved by ICEMA. The spreadsheet will be e-mailed to all Base Stations.
  - Submit spreadsheet via e-mail to Pam Winkler, [pwinkler@cao.sbcounty.gov](mailto:pwinkler@cao.sbcounty.gov) and copy to Ron Holk, [ron.holk@cao.sbcounty.gov](mailto:ron.holk@cao.sbcounty.gov).
  - Submit no later than the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month following the preceding month, e.g. July submit by August 15.
  - ICEMA to provide reports back to Base Stations quarterly.

July	By August 15th	Quarterly

2. Data represents the number of Base Station contacts with BLS and ALS units during the month. Determination is based on type of unit, not a determination by the Base Station as to level of treatment.
3. Base Station must provide all information on the spreadsheet.
